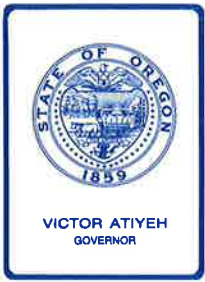

SUBJECT: State Revenue Sharing to Cities

State Revenue Sharing Law requires cities to pass an ordinance each year stating that they want to receive state revenue sharing money. The law also requires that cities certify that two required public hearings were held.

A sample ordinance and certification of hearings form is shown on the other side of this letter.

In order to receive state revenue sharing in 1982-83 a city must have levied property taxes in the year prior to the year revenue sharing is due, and:

1. Pass the appropriate ordinance and file it with the Intergovernmental Relations Division by July 31, 1982.
2. Hold at least one public hearing on state revenue sharing before the budget committee and certify this to the Intergovernmental Relations Division by July 31, 1982.
3. Hold at least one public hearing before the City Council on state revenue sharing and certify this to the Intergovernmental Relations Division by July 31, 1982.
