CITY OF SHERWOOD, OREGON

ORDINANCE NO. 790

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 591 WITH RESPECT TO THE OFFICE OF CITY ADMINISTRATOR, AND THE DUTIES THEREOF.

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subpart a of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 591, enacted October 8, 1969 by the City Council, as amended, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

> Exercise control and supervision of all activities, departments and offices of city government, except the office of municipal judge and city attorney; interview and recommend to the mayor and council concerning all applicants proposed for appointment to city offices; make recommendations to the mayor and council concerning the replacement of any city appointive officer, other than councilpersons; have authority to appoint to and remove from established positions subordinate employees of the city, including department heads in those departments under the Administrator's control.

The City Administrator shall not exercise his powers of supervision and control so as to interfere with the impartial enforcement of specific laws and duty of the police department to keep the public peace. The Chief of Police shall report to the City Administrator as required or needed and be under the direct supervision of the City Administrator, unless otherwise directed by motion or resolution of the City Council. The City Administrator shall in no event perform any duties with respect to the police department for which qualification as a peace officer is required.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.
