ORDINANCE NO. 795

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 530 AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, WITH RESPECT TO AN INCREASE IN SEWER LINE CONNECTION SURCHARGE, PROVISION FOR A SEWER LINE REPLACEMENT FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 417 of Ordinance 530 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 417. (a) Sewer connection charges for all users within the city who have not, prior to the effective date of this ordinance, made application for connection, paid connection fees, and been issued permits, shall be computed and charged in accordance with the connection fee schedule adopted by the Unified Sewerage Agency and currently in effect at the time the permit is issued. In addition to that connection charge and any applicable inspection fees, the permittee shall be charged a connection fee surcharge in the sum of \$150.00 for each connection permit issued after the effective date of this ordinance.

(b) There is hereby created a sewer facilities and system replacement reserve account. The sewer connection surcharge revenues collected pursuant to subparagraph (a) of this section shall be held in said sewer facilities and system replacement reserve account, together with such other funds as may be determined necessary to be required to provide for the depreciation of existing sewer line facilities and the replacement thereof upon the termination of the useful life of those facilities. Funds from said account shall be appropriated and expended only upon budget authorization of the city council.

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is necessary that the foregoing amendments be adopted immediately to provide the funds necessary for replacement of depreciated sewer facilities, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by the mayor and approval by the city council.
