SUBJECT: State Revenue Sharing to Cities

State Revenue Sharing Law requires cities to pass an ordinance each year stating that they want to receive state revenue sharing money. The law also requires that cities certify that two required public hearings were held.

A sample ordinance and certification of hearings form is shown on the back of this letter.

In order to receive state revenue sharing in 1985-86 your city <u>must have</u> levied property taxes in the preceding year and:

- 1. Pass an ordinance approving participation in the program and file a copy of that ordinance with the Intergovernmental Relations Division before July 31.
- 2. Hold the following hearings on the use of state revenue sharing funds:
 - a) a public hearing before the budget committee to discuss possible uses of the funds;
 - b) a public hearing before the city council on the <u>proposed</u> uses of the funds in relation to the entire budget.
- 3. Certify to the Intergovernmental Relations Division, before July 31, that these hearings have been held.
