ORDINANCE NO. 89-893

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING SOLID WASTE COLLECTION RATES IN THE CITY, UNDER THE AUTHORITY ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE NO. 816, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the last increase in solid waste collection rates in the City was for the purposes of passing through fee increases at regional landfills, and was approved by Ordinance No. 88-888, adopted November 9, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the last general solid waste collection rate increase was approved by Ordinance No. 87-863, adopted April 8, 1987; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 816, effective February 13, 1985, is a comprehensive solid waste franchise regulation, and specifies, among other things, the method and conditions of rate adjustments; and

WHEREAS, Pride Disposal, Inc., the current franchised solid waste hauler in the City, submitted notice to the City on October 4, 1988 of their proposal to increase rates, and submitted required income and expense information; and

WHEREAS, Pride submitted a revised proposal on November 4, 1988, and after a public hearing on November 9, 1988 the City Council approved a "pass-through" rate for landfill charges but deferred action on a general rate increase until January, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Pride Disposal has now submitted a third rate proposal dated December 28, 1988, and the Council received a presentation from Pride and conducted a second public hearing on the proposed rate increase on January 25, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Pride's current proposal includes several tiers of service options not previously included in the solid waste collection rate schedule, including curbside service, smaller garbage cans, and large wheeled garbage tote barrels, and such options will help Sherwood customers reduce or stabilize their monthly garbage bills; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of encouraging recycling and further moderating the present and future costs of collecting and disposing of solid waste, the City proposes to modify Pride's request by adding differential rate structures for recycling and non-recycling customers.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance 89-893 January 25, 1989 Page 1 Section 1. Review. That the City's franchised solid waste hauler, Pride Disposal, Inc., has submitted all required financial information and said information has been subject to a full and proper review.

Section 2. Public Hearing. That the City Council conducted public hearings on the proposed collection rate increases on November 9, 1988 and, based on a modified proposal, conducted a second hearing on January 25, 1989, and all interested parties were afforded an opportunity to be heard.

Section 3. Findings of Fact. That the current rate proposal, attached hereto as Exhibit A, featuring numerous service options and some actual reductions in some rates, represents a fair and reasonable rate schedule, and therefore is hereby APPROVED and ADOPTED.

Section 4. Definitions. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 816 is hereby amended to incorporate the following new definitions:

- Recycling customer A regular customer of the franchisee who enrolls in the recycling program and provides recyclable materials curbside at least once monthly, as determined by the franchisee's records.
- Nonrecycling customer A regular customer of the franchisee that elects not to enroll in the recycling program or fails to provide recyclable materials at least once monthly, as determined by the franchisee's records.
- Carry-out Service Service whereby the franchisee will collect properly stored solid waste located on the customer's property, provided said waste is clearly visible and accessible to the franchisee.
- Curb-side Service Service whereby the franchisee will collect properly stored solid waste placed by the customer alongside a public street or some other location designated by the franchisee.
- Tote Barrel A wheeled, 60 gallon, rigid plastic garbage can provided by the franchisee to their customers.
- Standard Can A 32 gallon metal or rigic plastic garbage can.
- 20 Gallon Can A 20 gallon metal or rigid plastic garbage can.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective March 1, 1989.
