### ORDINANCE NO. 90-911

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, OREGON, JUNE 26, 1990, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY THE QUESTION OF APPROVING A SERIAL LEVY FOR CITY OPERATIONS PURSUANT TO ORS 280.060, ET SEQ. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sherwood finds that the existing tax base provides insufficient funds to operate all essential functions of the City government, and that there should be submitted to the legal voters, a fiveyear serial levy to provide funds in addition to those funds provided within the tax base to provide funds for library services, add necessary staff to the police department, to fund parks maintenance and fund other City operations; and

WHEREAS, it appears this matter should be submitted to the voters at the June 26, 1990, special election; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the amount required for operations in addition to sums budgeted from the general fund, for each of five years for the period commencing July 1, 1990, and ending June 30, 1995, is \$252,667, for a total of \$1,263,335, said proposed serial levy being outside the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is necessary and in the best interest of the people of the City of Sherwood that there be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Sherwood at special election to be held June 26, 1990, the proposition hereinafter set forth for a serial levy outside the limitation provided by Section II, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for which purpose a special election is hereby called on said date.

Section 2. There shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Sherwood for their approval or rejection, the following serial levy measure for which the following ballot titles to appear on the ballots are prescribed:

## Explanation

This measure, if approved, will authorize the City of Sherwood to levy property taxes outside the tax base in the amount of \$252,667, serially, each year for five (5) years commencing fiscal year 1990-91 and ending fiscal year 1994-95, for a total tax levy for five years of \$1,263,335 outside the tax base. The funds will be used for the operating expenses of the City library, provision of added police officers, expanded parks maintenance, additional clerical and planning services, office and operating equipment needs, special projects such as the Sherwood Centennial and Old Town revitalization, matching funds for State and Federal grants, and to fund other City operations above any amount budgeted to be paid from the general fund. By law, the money provided by this levy may only be used for operations.

# City Recorder

Section 5. The City Recorder be and she is hereby authorized and directed to cause the county elections officer to have prepared ballots in due and legal form as herein prescribed and to take any and all other and further actions necessary to conduct the election in accordance with the laws regulating and governing elections.

It is necessary for the orderly conduct of the election and to comply with the statutory time requirements for submitting election information to the county elections officer prior to the special election date, and therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist. This ordinance shall therefore be effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
