AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SOLID WASTE COLLECTION RATES IN THE CITY AS SET BY PRIOR CITY ORDINANCE NO. 89-897, AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF "SOLID WASTE" AS SET BY PRIOR ORDINANCE NO. 89-899, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, solid waste collection in the City of Sherwood is regulated by a franchise to Pride Disposal, Inc., and the terms and conditions of said franchise are set by City Ordinance No. 89-899, adopted October 25, 1989; and

WHEREAS, collection rates were last amended in the City by Ordinance No. 89-897, adopted July 26, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 89-899 permits the adjustment of rates to "pass-through" increases in land fill disposal rates set by the Metropolitan Service District, and said land fill rates are scheduled to increase on July 1, 1990 from \$44.75 per ton to \$55.50 per ton, which increases translate to approximately \$0.70 per can in the City; and

WHEREAS, Pride Disposal provided the City with notice of a proposed local rate increase to account for changes in landfill disposal rates on June 11, 1990; and

WHEREAS, Pride Disposal also proposes rates for some new or amended services, and also proposes a change to franchise language to redefine the term "solid waste" to be consistent with State statutes that went into effect on July 1, 1990.

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1. Rates Amended.</u> The rates established by Ordinance No. 89-897 are amended as per the attached Exhibit "A".

<u>Section 2. Definitions.</u> The definition of "solid waste" contained in Ordinance No. 89-899, Section 3(13)(a), is hereby amended to read:

"All putrescible and non-putrescible wastes, including, but not limited to garbage, rubbish, refuse, ashes, waste paper, cardboard, yard debris, compost, tires, equipment and furniture; commercial, industrial, demolition and construction wastes; discarded or abandoned vehicles or parts thereof; discarded home or industrial appliances; manure, vegetable and animal solid and semi-solid wastes, dead animals, infectious waste as defined in Section 3 of Chapter 763, Oregon Laws 1989 and other wastes"

Section 3. Effective Date. As landfill rates charged by the Metropolitan Service District increased July 1, 1990, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective as of July 1, 1990 after passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
