ORDINANCE NO. 91-926

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 88-889 BY REDUCING THE NUMBER OF CITY LIBRARY ADVISORY BOARD MEETINGS PER CALENDAR YEAR FROM TWELVE TO SIX, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Library Advisory Board was established in 1988 and is required by ordinance to meet twelve times annually, and

WHEREAS, the Library Advisory Board feels that a less frequent meeting cycle would be adequate to discharge Library business and recommended at its June 3, 1991 meeting that only six meetings annually be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance Amended. Section 4(d) of Ordinance No. 88-889 is hereby amended to read:

"(d) The Board shall hold at least six (6) meetings per calendar year and may hold other meetings as are necessary to perform its functions."

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after its enactment by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
