ORDINANCE NO. 95-998

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 514, REGULATING CITY WATER SERVICE AND CHARGES, AS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED ON MAY 5, 1961, AND SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City adopted Ordinance No. 514, regulating water service and charges in the City of Sherwood, on May 5, 1961, and has subsequently amended said Ordinance several times, most recently in 1994 through Ordinance No. 94-988; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to encourage conservation through inverted block rates for residential customers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council also finds that conservation would be encouraged by monthly billing; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Water User Charges. Section 5a is hereby amended to read:

(a) Based on the size of the water meter, the following monthly rates shall be charged customers for use of water supplied within the corporate limits of the City of Sherwood.

For the first 100 gallons:

3/4"	\$4.00
1"	4.95
1-1/2"	8.80
2"	12.80
3"	25.75
4"	44.00
6"	91.35
8"	169.10

FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS:

- a) Each additional 100 gallons UP TO 21,000: \$.205
- b) Over 21,000 gallons: \$.307

FOR NONRESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

- a) Each additional 100 gallons: \$.220

The City Manager is hereby directed to have twelve percent (12) of the annual revenue from water user charges deposited in the City Water System Replacement Reserve Fund.

Section 2: Exceptions. Section 5(h) is deleted in its entirety.

Section 3: Payment for Service. Section 11 (b) and (c) are changed to read:

(b) Charges shall become a lien on the property served; and if not paid within 30 days after billing, the customer shall be notified in writing that service will be disconnected; and if not paid within 10 days thereafter, the service will be disconnected without further notice.


(c) Water service disconnected for lack of payment of bills shall not be restored until all past-due bills are paid, plus a \$20.00 charge to cover the cost of turning the water off and on.

Section 4: Penalties. Section 22 is amended by adding the following: In addition to any other remedies provided by this ordinance or by law, the City may refuse to issue any permit to any person who is delinquent in any payment due the City.

Section 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective on June 25, 1995 so as to be coincident with the normal City water billing cycle.
