ORDINANCE NO. 98-1039

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 529 WITH RESPECT TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR

---

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance 529 repealed by Article X of Ordinance 641 is hereby replaced with a new Section 5A., which shall read as follows:

"Section 5A. Employees Over 18 Years of Age. Nothing contained in Sections 6, 7, 8 and 9 shall be construed to prohibit activities authorized by ORS 471.375, 471.480, and 471.482 with respect to lawful service by employees 18 years of age or older."

Section 2. Section 13 of Ordinance 529 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 13. Consumption of Liquor in Beer Parlor. No licensee or his employee or agent shall knowingly permit any alcoholic liquor containing more than 14 percent of alcohol by volume to be brought upon or consumed upon the premise which he controls where the license of that premise permits only the sale and consumption of malt beverages."

Section 3. Section 15 of Ordinance 529 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. Section 26 of Ordinance 529 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 26. Civil Penalty. Violation of any provision of this ordinance is punishable, upon conviction in the municipal court, by a civil fine not exceeding \$500.00."

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after its passage and approval.
