ORDINANCE NO. 98-1040

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND UPDATING ORDINANCE NO. 530 REGULATING SEWERS

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 402 of Ordinance 530 is amended to read as follows:

Section 402. Building sewer permits for residential, commercial, and industrial uses shall be subject to permit application requirements and payment of permit fees, inspection fees, as from time to time set by the council by ordinance or resolution, or set pursuant to agreement with the City and Unified Sewerage Agency of Washington County.

Section 2. Section 413 of Ordinance 530 is amended to read as follows:


Section 413. Owners required to connect to the city sewers pursuant to this or any other ordinance of the city of Sherwood shall, at the time of filing application for a permit for sewer connections as required under Section 402 of this ordinance, in addition to the sewer connection charges, as hereinafter prescribed, pay to the city a fee to cover the costs of inspection of the work proposed under such permit. The applicant for the connection permit shall thereafter promptly notify the city superintendent when the building sewer service line is read for connection to the city's system; and the connection to the city's system shall be undertaken only under supervision of the city director of public works or the director's representative.

Section 3. Section 802 of Ordinance 530 is amended to read as follows:

Section 802. Any person who shall continue any violation beyond the time limit provided for in Section 801 shall be guilty of a civil infraction and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not exceeding \$100.00 for each violation. Each day in which any such violation shall continue shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its passage and approval.
