

CITY OF SHERWOOD
ORDINANCE NO. 98-1046

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 799 ENACTED FEBRUARY 9, 1984, WITH RESPECT TO DISPOSITION OF ABANDONED, FOUND, SEIZED AND STOLEN PROPERTY, BY PROVIDING USE OF ALTERNATE METHODS OF DISPOSITION OF UNCLAIMED PROPERTY AS DEFINED BY ORS 98.245, AND CORRECTING STATUTORY REFERENCES.

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance 799 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection (f):


"(f) In lieu of the procedures set forth in subparts (a) through (e) of this section, the City Police Department may dispose of 'unclaimed property' as defined in ORS 98.245(b) in the manner set forth in ORS 98.245(2)."

Section 2. Section 6 of Ordinance 799 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. Scope. This ordinance shall apply to all personal property except motor vehicles now or hereafter in the custody of the City of Sherwood, weapons subject to ORS 166.280, property the disposition of which is subject to court order, and intangible personal property presumed abandoned pursuant to ORS 98.302 to 98.436."


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after its passage and approval.
