CITY OF SHERWOOD ORDINANCE NO. 98-1047

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 807 ENACTED JULY 11, 1984, TO MAKE SAME CONSISTENT WITH ORS CHAPTER 221.180

WHEREAS, since enactment of Ordinance 807, Oregon Revised Statutes have been revised as to the times for elections and times for getting candidate certified to the county elections officer, and the Council finds that Ordinance No. 807 should be amended to be consistent therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance 807 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. Time for Filing. A declaration of candidacy shall be filed not later than the 70th day before the date of the general election, nor sooner than the 15th day after the date of the biennial primary election. A nomination petition shall be filed not later than 80 days before the date of the election for the office for which the nomination petition is being filed, nor more than 250 days prior to said election date."

Section 2. Section 9 of Ordinance 807 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 9. Withdrawal of Candidacy. candidate who has filed a declaration of candidacy or a nomination petition may withdraw not later than the 67th day before the date of the election by filing a written statement of withdrawal with the officer with whom the declaration of candidacy nomination petition was filed. statement shall be signed and acknowledged by the candidate before a notary public and state the reason for withdrawal."

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after its passage and approval.
