ORDINANCE NO. 98-1056

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 700 WITH RESPECT TO MOVING BUILDINGS

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The first sentence of Section 3 of Ordinance 700 is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Pursuant to the State Structural Specialty Code, as adopted in Sherwood City Ordinance 1028 as amended, a building permit is required for all buildings moved to a location within the City.

**Section 2.** Section 4 of Ordinance 700 is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. Penalties. Any person, firm, corporation or other entity violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). In the event any provision of this ordinance is violated by a firm or corporation, the officer or officers or person or persons in charge and responsible for the violation shall also be subject to the penalties herein provided.

**Section 3.** Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its passage and approval.
