**Ordinance No. 98-1065**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION  
STANDARD DRAWINGS FOR THE CITY OF SHERWOOD AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sherwood's currently implements Construction Standards from Washington County to regulate construction of public improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, it has become necessary for the City of Sherwood to adopt its own Construction Standards of all City improvements, in order to meet present and future demands of the community; and <sup>Drawings</sup>

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance shall incorporate and establish new Construction <sup>Drawings</sup> Standards and shall be the accepted standard which will take precedence over any other agency standard for the City of Sherwood.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: The City of Sherwood Construction <sup>Drawings</sup> Standards, are attached hereto as Exhibit A, and hereby APPROVED AND ADOPTED in its entirety and supersedes all prior adopted Construction Drawing Standards.

Section 2: Because it is necessary to have standardized <sup>Drawings & Specifications</sup> specifications for construction, whether the construction be pursuant to public contract, or to private development, in place to protect the interest of public health, safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be effective upon its approval and adoption by the City Council and the Mayor.
