

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-1086

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII OF ORDINANCE NO. 500 WITH RESPECT TO PARKING TO PROVIDE FOR DISABLED PARKING IN OLD TOWN

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood desires to provide on-street parking for disabled persons to the extent possible; and

WHEREAS, requests have been made to the City from businesses having customers needing disabled person parking,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Disabled Person Parking. Chapter VII of Ordinance No. 599 is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 11, to be codified as 10.08.080:

“Disabled Persons Parking. The City Manager is directed to establish by proper signing and designation, reserved street parking space or spaces, as needed for disabled persons, which parking spaces shall be subject to the rules and regulations of the Oregon Revised Statutes for disabled persons parking.

Section 2. The City Manager is directed to cause standard traffic signs to be installed or removed as necessary to carry out the foregoing provision.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after its enactment by City Council and approval by the Mayor.
