## **ORDINANCE NO. 2001-1117**

# AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS ON CITY PROPERTY

The City of Sherwood ordains as follows:

## Section 1. Definitions.

The following definitions apply to this Ordinance:

(1) Smoking - Any inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying any lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, weed, plant or other tobacco or tobacco-like product or substance in any manner or any form.

(2) Tobacco Product - Any tobacco, cigarette, cigar, pipe tobacco, smokeless tobacco, chewing tobacco, or any other form of tobacco which may utilized for smoking, chewing, inhalation, or any other means of ingestion.

(3) Tobacco Use - Smoking, chewing or other ingestion of any tobacco product.

#### Section 2. Tobacco Use Prohibited.

Tobacco use is prohibited on any City-owned, controlled or managed property, with the exclusion of public right-of-way, including, but not limited to Cityowned buildings, parks, vehicles and other real and personal property.

## Section 3. Violation of this Ordinance.

Violation of this Ordinance in an infraction punishable by fine of not less than  $500^{22}$ , nor more than  $500^{22}$ .

# Section 4. Severability.

If any provision, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

# Section 5. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
