

Ordinance 2002-1138, NOT USED, Postponed to 2003. See Ord. 2003-1141

assists coaching the players on any team resigning community facilities.

“Spectator” shall mean any person, other than a team player or coach, who observes the playing of any game on community facilities.

**Section 2. Authority to eject.** Any game official of a game or sports event who has reason to believe that a coach or spectator is exhibiting serious unsportsmanlike conduct, abusive behavior, threatening conduct, or other conduct that interferes or threatens to interfere with the game or the game officials’ ability to officiate the game, may order that the offending person be ejected from the game, and from the community facilities where the game is being conducted.

**Section 3.** Any coach or spectator who is the subject of an ejection order by a game official shall voluntarily and promptly remove his or her person from the game area and the community facilities where the game is being conducted. Remaining on site after being ordered to leave the game and facilities is prohibited. Section 3. violation of Section 2 of this Chapter is a Class C violation C, City of Sherwood Municipal Code 9.12.030 for the first offense. Subsequent violations of Section 2. of this chapter shall contribute a Class B violation.

**Section 4. Banning from use of facilities.** Any coach who is ejected by a game official during a game played on community facilities shall be banned from use of community sports facilities for games, practice, or other uses for a period of one week. A second ejection of the same coach during the same calendar year, shall be banned from use of community sports facilities for games, practices, or other uses for a period of two weeks. A third ejection of the same coach within the same calendar year shall be banned from use of community sports facilities for a period of one year running from the date of the third ejection.

**Section 5. Review.** Any coach who has been banned from use of community facilities may apply to the City Manager in writing for review of circumstances of the coach’s banishment. The City Manager shall promptly hear and consider any mitigating circumstances, and may affirm the banishment period, suspend all or a remaining portion of the banishment period, or suspend with conditions all or a portion of the remaining portion of the banishment period.

**Section 6. Severability.** If any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph of the chapter or the application thereof shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions of this chapter which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this chapter are declared to be severable.

**Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after its enactment by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
