

ORDINANCE 2007-013

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE WITH OREGON AMENDMENTS ADOPTED April 1, 2007 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood currently enforces the 2004 Oregon Fire Code as adopted by the State of Oregon for plan review, permits and inspections; previously adopted by Ordinance 2006-004 and referenced in the Sherwood Municipal Code, section 8.12.010; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon Fire Marshall and Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue have adopted an updated version of the Oregon Fire Code based on the 2006 International Fire Code as published by the International Code Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Sherwood Building Official shall use the 2007 Oregon Fire Code adopted April 1, 2007, for administration, inspection and plan review.

Section 2. Effective Date. It is necessary that the 2007 Oregon Fire Code be effective immediately so that there is no question the City is complying with the state's mandate to enforce the most current codes which in turn will promote the peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Sherwood; as such an emergency is declared and this ordinance is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the Council.
