

Sherwood, Oregon, April 8, 1935.

WHEREAS, As it is deemed advisable for the City of Sherwood to purchase a garbage dump of its own, that it might be maintained and operated in more of a satisfactory manner than the dump now leased from the Federal Land Bank of Spokane;

NOW THEREFORE; the city council do hereby authorize the Mayor of the City of Sherwood to enter into and negotiate with, and offer the Federal Land Bank of Spokane, the sum of \$50⁰⁰ for the tract of land of about one and a quarter acres now being used and maintained as a city dump under lease from the aforesaid Federal Land Bank of Spokane.

The city recorder is hereby authorized to spread a copy of this resolution upon the minutes of this meeting, and deliver a copy to the Mayor for his authority in negotiating with the Federal Land Bank of Spokane for the purchase of said tract of land.
