Fursuant to call of Mayor Morback, the City Council of the City of Sherwood met in special session and was presided over by Mayor Morback. Roll call showed all members of the council present excepting councilman Lawrenze. Being a special meeting, minuts and other regular business were dispensed with.

The meeting being particurarly called for for further consideration of the South Side Sewer matter, it appearing at this time a petition having been filed with the Recorder of the City signed by the owners of more than sixty per cent of the property in the proposed sewer district, and upon which assessments to pay for the same, would be levied, praying for the construction of a sewer system in that pertion of the City of Sherwood therein designated, and said petition was now considered by the council and approved.
