

Sherwood, Ore., June 5, 1925.

The City Council met in regular monthly session and was presided over by Mayor Morback. On roll call councilmen Snyder, Young, Lawrenz and Suppe were present.

The minutes of the last regular and special meetings were read and approved as read.

The contract for the construction of the South Side Sanitary Sewer and Septic Tank to be tendered Mr. B.C. Seydel was then read and approved by the Council.

The following resolution was then introduced, viz:- Resolution. Whereas the City Council of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, has accepted the bid of B.C. Seydel to furnish materials and to construct a sanitary sewerage system and a septic tank in the South Side Sanitary Sewer District in the said City, for the sum of \$5440.00, Now, be it therefor Resolved, that the Mayor and the Recorder of said City be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract, for and on behalf of said City, with the said B.C. Seydel in accordance with said bid and pursuant to the plans and specifications provided therefor by the City Engineer. Upon motion duly made and seconded this resolution was accepted all members of the Council voting Aye.
