An Ordinance was then introduced entitled "An Ordinance licensing, regulating and controlling the disposal and sale at retail of non-intoxicating beverages; fixing the amount of license fees; providing for the revocation of licenses; prohibiting the sale of giving away to persons under the age of twenty-one years; providing other terms and conditions; Providing penalties for the violation thereof; repealing Ordinance No.101 of the City of Sherwood And declaring an emergency."

A motion was made and seconded that the Ordinance be read a first time by sections and in full. The motion was carried by unanimous vote and the Ordinance read and seconded

A motion was then made that the Ordinance be read a second time by title only. The roll was called upon this motion and the vote stood: Ayes--Lawrenz, Sheffer and Muralt. Nays--None. So the Ordinance was read a second time by title only.

A motion was then made and seconded that the Ordinance be read a third time by sections and in full and placed upon its final passage. The motion was adopted by unanimous vote and the Ordinance was then read a third time in full and seconded

A motion was then made that the Ordinance do now pass. The roll was called upon the motion and the vote stood: Ayes--Lawrenz, Sheffer and Muralt. Nays--None. So the Ordinance was declared duly passed and numbered 115 and ordered enrolled.

No other business appearing before the Council that body adjourned in regular form.
