

Sherwood, Oregon, October 26th, 1934.

On this date the Sherwood City Council met in special session with Mayor Morbeck presiding and Councilmen Shaffer, Mursalt, Lawrenz and Cunningham present.

This being the time set for hearing objections to the proposed budget and amount to be raised by general taxation for ~~all~~ the general fund of the City of Sherwood for the fiscal year 1935, that matter was taken up. And no objections having been filed and no one present objecting to the proposed budget as read, an Ordinance was introduced authorizing the levying board of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, to raise the sum of \$3000.00 by general tax on all taxable property within the City of Sherwood, Oregon.

A motion was made that the Ordinance be read a first time by sections and in full. The motion was seconded and passed and the Ordinance read by sections and in full.
and seconded.

Another motion was made that the rules be suspended with and the Ordinance read a second time by title only. ~~The motion was seconded and passed.~~ The roll was called upon the motion and the vote stood: Ayes, Shaffer, Lawrenz, Mursalt and Cunningham. Nays, None. So the motion carried and the Ordinance read by title only.

A motion was made that the Ordinance be read a third time by sections and in full and placed upon its final passage. The motion was seconded and passed so the Ordinance was read for the third time.

Another motion was then made and seconded that the Ordinance do now pass. The roll was called upon the motion and the vote stood: Ayes; Shaffer, Lawrenz, Mursalt, and Cunningham. Nays; None. So the Ordinance was declared duly adopted and numbered 118 and ordered enrolled.

A motion was then made and seconded to adjourn. Motion carried.
