

Sherwood, Oregon, December 4, 1936.

UPON UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE COUNCIL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS PASSED.

WHEREAS: Owing to the depleted condition of the general account of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, with no further anticipated receipts until the first quarter tax payments in 1937, and inasmuch as the road account of the City of Sherwood maintains a substantial balance:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The city council in regular session convened does hereby authorize the city Recorder to draw a warrant against the road account for \$300.00, transferring and depositing said amount to the credit of the general account of the city, which amount is to be reimbursed the road fund at such a time as there are sufficient funds on hand in the general account to do so.
