

Sherwood, Oregon
December 18th, 1936

Pursuant to adjournment of the last regular meeting the Sherwood City Council met at the call of Mayor Morback, with all of the Councilmen present.

Attorney P.L. Patterson was present and presented an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Defining and Regulating Public Dances and Dance Halls Within the City of Sherwood, Oregon; Prescribing Penalties for Violations of this Ordinance; Repealing All Ordinances In Conflict Herewith; And Declaring An Emergency."

Cunningham moved that the Ordinance be read a first time by Section and in full. The motion was seconded by Lawrenz and passed by unanimous vote, and was thereupon read a first time by sections and in full.

Cunningham then moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance read a second time by title only. The motion was seconded by Muralt and the roll was called upon the motion and the vote stood: Ayes, Cunningham, Muralt, Lawrenz Shaffer. Nays, None. So the motion carried and the Ordinance was read a second time by title only.

A motion was then made and seconded that the Ordinance be read a third time by sections and in full and placed upon its final passage. The motion carried by unanimous vote and the Ordinance was read a third time by sections and in full. Roll call upon this motion was: Ayes, Shaffer, Cunningham, Muralt, Lawrenz. Nays, None.

A motion was then made and seconded that the Ordinance do now pass. The roll call upon the motion was: Ayes, Shaffer, Cunningham, Lawrenz, Muralt. Nays, None. So the Ordinance was declared duly adopted and ordered enrolled and numbered 127.

The meeting then adjourned.
