Minutes of a meeting of the Sherwood City Council held pursuant to advertising and posting of notices of budget meeting for the year of 1938. There were present at this meeting Mayor Merback; Councilman Cunningham, Muralt, and Shaffer; and Floyd Sheep, Recorder.

No one being present to protest or object the budget for 1938 as advertised and posted, an Ordinance was introduced instructing the Recorder to authorize the County Assessor of Washington County to extend the budget in the amount of \$3000.00 upon the tax rolls of all taxable property within the City of Sherwood for the year 1938.

A motion was made and seconded that the Ordinance be read a first time by sections and in full. The motion carried and the Ordinance was read a first time by section and in full.


Another motion was made and seconded that the rules be suspended with and the Ordinance be read a second time by title only. The roll was called upon the motion and the vote stood: Ayes, Cunningham, Shaffer, Muralt. Nays; None. So the motion carried and the Ordinance was read a second time by title only.


A motion was then made that the Ordinance be read a third time by sections and in full and placed upon its final passage. The motion was seconded and passed so the Ordinance was read the third time.

Another motion was then made that the Ordinance do now pass. The roll was called upon the motion and the vote stood: Ayes, Cunningham, Shaffer, Muralt. Nays, None. The Ordinance was declared duly adopted and Numbered and ordered enrolled.

The meeting then adjourned in regular form.
