November 5th, 1941

On this date the Sherwood City Council met in regular session for the month of November with the following members present: Mayor Morback, and Councilmen Muralt, Sanders and Martin present.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read.

Budget for the first six month of 1942 was read.

An Ordinance was introduced setting forth the tax levy for the first six months of the year of 1942. A motion was made by Sanders and seconded by Muralt that the Ordinance be adopted as read. The roll was called upon the motion and the vote stood: Ayes: Muralt, Sanders and Martin. Nays: None. So the ~~Ordinance~~ Ordinance was duly adopted.

It was decided to put small gravel on the walk ~~and~~ ^{on the} fill on Washington Street between Railroad and Willametts streets.
