Approval of Minutes

Minutes could not be approved due to the lack of a quorum. Only two commission members were present. Approval of minutes to be addressed at the next meeting.

Review of SURPAC meeting held on 5/15/02

Kristen briefly updated the commission on this meeting and handed out the three different options that SURPAC presented to the public on the Old Town Street Design, with the following ideas for a future Theater, Library and City Hall.

Option 1: Having the Library, Theater and City hall located in one building.

Option 2: Build an indoor/outdoor Theater at the location of the current Police Station and move the Morback House (current Police Station) to the current Public Works facility across from Stella Olsen Park.

Option 3: Rebuild theater at current location. Build the Library and City hall at the Garragus building location.

Option 3 appeared to be the popular option. The option 3 map can be viewed on the City' website. On July 9th, option 3 should go to City Council. After this decision is final, the SCAC will have input in determining the style/design of the new theater. As far as parking, underground parking was discussed as a possibility.

Music on the Green

This year' poster was designed by Karen Tasker. Posters will be handed out to local business to post and a flyer/card type of announcement will also be created so that business can hand them out to their customers. Bernie suggested possibly having Safeway & Albertson's place an announcement in their customer's grocery bags.

There will also be an insert in the July issue of the Gazette with a write up of this year's entertainment.

So far, \$3600.00 has been collected in donations/sponsorships for Music on the Green.

Details on the food and beverage vendors are still in the works. At this time, Santa Fe Grill and Delivery Depot will possibly provide food booths.

Kristen is looking to set up a City booth with the Theater's popcorn machine and concession candy to sell.

Cultural Arts Classes

We are looking at cultural arts type classes to fill the void of the closed Theater. At this time the details of contacting and contracting instructors are being worked out. Instructors to teach classes on drawing, painting, jewelry making, music instruction, dance instruction, etc. are being discussed. Kristen will be posting an announcement calling for instructors in the July issue of the Gazette. Kristen has meet with Peggi, the Senior Center Director, and is scheduled to meet with the Sherwood School District. The City has budgeted \$5000.00 for this next fiscal year 02-03, for activities of this type.

The past years' Arts Festivals were briefly discussed, with Karen Tasker to contact Beth Rapp.

Movies in the Park

Movies in the Park is another possible event Kristen is looking into. Kristen has been in contact with N. Clackamas Parks & Rec. Dept. gathering information. So far, the information provided is the fee for the movie and big screen set up, which is \$300.00 per event. The commission briefly discussed the time frame to show movies, best day of the week, number of occurrences for the summer months and the type of movies, IE. Black & White, family etc. Other suggestions: City would not charge a fee for the movie, would have a concession stand and possibly a donation box. Bernie suggested a movie theme for this series of movies.

Bernie informed the commission of the flyer put out by The Robin Hood Theater Assoc. on a performance that is scheduled August 22, 2002.
