- 1. Adjustments to Agenda-
 - No adjustments.
- 2. Approval of Minutes-
 - Unable to approve meeting notes due to lack of quorum
- 3. Missoula items discussed, no voting took place
 - Dave will consider having the Sherwood Dance Academy host the Missoula Workshops
- 4. Arts Festival items discussed, no voting took place
 - Pam will run the kids activity area, we will use 10x10 tents from the City rather than renting a large 30x50 tent
 - We will not need side walls for the tents
 - We will use existing tables rather than renting
 - Bernie will contact Tech Audio to find out what is included in rental
 - Lindsey will find out how many trash cans were used last year by Public Works
 - Bernie will contact Pride and Porta Pottie rentals and try to get donated for event
 - Someone from the Robin Hood Festival will be the MC for the event
 - Lindsey will talk to Ross about closing the L shape road from Rail Road and Washington to Pine and First
 - Lindsey will contact Lew Jones and Dub Dubrie and book them for the entertainment
 - Dave will confirm a dance group for entertainment
 - Robyn will call Voices of Performing Arts to see if they will perform
