MEETING NOTES

1. Adjustments to Agenda-
 - No adjustments were made to the agenda.
2. Approval of Minutes-
 - Patti Barrow motioned to approve the November 2007 minutes. Shelly seconded, all in favor, motion carries to approve November 2007 minutes.
3. Council Update- Linda Henderson
 - City Manager Ross Schultz plans on retiring in August.
 - At the next SURPAC meeting, they will be focusing on the Cannery redevelopment.
4. Cultural Arts/Community Center Steering Committee Update- Linda Henderson
 - The results are in from the Cultural Arts survey. 72% desire a large multi-purpose room with a stage. The survey also showed the community's desire for a third party (non-profit or other) to operate the building. The Council has directed staff to move forward with the next step in the feasibility /needs assessment.
5. Comedy Sportz Recap- Patti/Robyn
 - All agreed that a sponsor next year would be beneficial.
 - Getting schools involved in advertising is key.
 - It was discussed that it may be worth having a summer and a winter show.
6. Holiday Art Walk Recap- Patti
 - Overall, the event was a success. The High School teacher wants to do it every year. It was a great opportunity to show talent in community, both kids and professionals. It was suggested that there be an art show during the Robin Hood Festival or Cruisin' Sherwood. Kristen mentioned that if the Commission was interested in doing something like that they would need to contact those organizations directly and see if it was something that they were in support of.
7. Introduce Artist Jesse Swickard-
 - Jesse presented a public art/sculpture program that he helped start in Wilsonville. They pay \$500 per sculpture to rent it from the artist. The City found the designated the land and poured the pads. Jesse handed out brochures and pictures from Wilsonville. Jesse expressed an interest in getting something similar started in Sherwood.
 - Discussion followed as to which organization could help with this project- the Commission or the Foundation? Discussion to be continued at the next meeting and as the Foundation develops.
8. Introduce Heather Maxwell- Heather
 - Heather is from YMCA. She is in charge of the YMCA Art Show, which is a fundraising opportunity. The Art Show will be March 2nd-16th. A reception will be held March 8th from 5-7pm. Heather is concerned about getting food and items donated. The commission gave suggestions as to where to see donations and asked Heather to come back to the next meeting if she needed anything.

9. Upcoming Events/Possibilities- Kristen

- Dates for Music on the Green were discussed because of Washington Street Culvert project. It was recommended to just run Music on the Green for the month of July. (5 weeks)
- Other upcoming events:

 - Cruisin' Sherwood—June 14th
