MEETING NOTES

- Adjustments to Agenda
 - No adjustments to the agenda were made.
- Approval of Minutes
 - Ashley Marshall-O'Dell motioned to approve the April 2009 minutes. Darla Boljat seconded, all in favor, motion carries to approve the April 2009 minutes.*
- Missoula Update –Patti
 - There is one opening in the second session and nine openings in the first session.
 - One teacher has a cat allergy and won't be able to stay in a home that has a cat.
 - There will be workshops this year provided by Missoula. Patti will find the workshop schedule on Missoula's website and let Kristen know which date she prefers. Missoula needs to know the date of the workshop ahead of time.
- Movies in the Park Update—Patti
 - Disney still requires that 200 maximum people to attend their films.
 - The Commission all agreed to not show any Disney films.
 - The Commission decided on the following films:

- August 14th— Journey to the Center of Earth
 - August 21st— Goonies
 - August 28th— Monsters vs. Aliens/Raiders of the Lost Ark
5. Raffle for Music on the Green—Patti
 - Shelly passed out a list of businesses who donated in years past. Each person signed up for a different business development. (see exhibit A)
 - The Commission decided that the profit from the raffle will go to the Sherwood Foundation for the Arts
 6. Stage Cover Updates—Kristen
 - The Stage Cover construction has begun. They will be digging holes later this week.
 - There won't be any lights this year, as this was not included in the design
 - They are scheduled to be done July 1st. There is a fee in place for each event canceled due to late completion.
 7. Cultural Center Follow Up—Kristen
 - Before anything proceeds further, we have to wait until the PUD (Planned Urban Development) is complete in July. After it is complete, then the proposal for the Cannery site needs to be adopted, and would therefore become a genuine project of the City's.
 - Discussion followed regarding what are the true needs of the community. The Commission continued to imagine how this facility would come about and support the most needs. Patti will go to the SURPAC meeting the 3rd Wednesday in June and let them know the Commission's interest and community support for the project.
 8. Commission Opening—Patti
 - Kathleen Gould put in her resignation which creates an opening on the Commission.
 - Griff O'Brien may be moving out of town.
 9. Council Update—Linda/Robyn
 - Robyn shared about the budget. The Council will be hearing Public Testimony on June 2nd. The budget should be adopted on June 16th.
 10. Other
 - The Little Red Truck is an award-winning documentary film about the Missoula Children's Theatre. For the next 12 months the movie can be offered for free to raise awareness of Missoula Children's Theatre or as a fundraiser. (see exhibit B)
