

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, W.A. Snyder and Anna Snyder, his wife, of Sherwood, Washington County Oregon, for an in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars to us paid by the Town of Sherwood, a municipal corporation, of Washington County, Oregon, does hereby covenant and agrees to permit the Town of Sherwood to lay a six inch water main not less than thirty six inches under the surface of the ground, and two hundred and twenty seven feet in length diagonally across the Northeast corner of their 14 acre tract of land, in Section 32, Township 2, South of Range 1 Wes.

And W.A. Snyder and Anna Snyder further covenant and agrees that they will permit the Town of Sherwood after the main is layed to enter upon the land at any time it may become necessary to make repairs and improvements on the said water main.

The Town of Sherwood covenant and agrees with W.A. Snyder and Anna Snyder, that should it become necessary at any time to enter upon the land above mentioned for the purpose of making repairs and improvements, that they will pay a fair and reasonable damage for any and all damages that might be incurred in making such repairs and improvements. However, should W.A. Snyder and Anna Snyder and the Town of Sherwood disagree at any time as to what would be deemed a fair and reasonable price for damages that might be incurred by the Town of Sherwood, then an arbitration committee of three is to be appointed for to determine such damages. W.A. Snyder and Wife to appoint one of such committee, the Town of Sherwood one, and the two so appointed to appoint the third. And all decisions and findings of said committee shall be final.
