## WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Merwyn P. Chapman and Lucille M. Chapman, husband and wife, grantors, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars, to us in hand paid by the CITY OF SHERWOOD, Oregon, a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon, grantee, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee and its assigns, all the following real property, with the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances, situated in the County of Washington and State of Oregon, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

- 1. Beginning at an iron pipe that is south Ol<sup>O</sup> 16' East a distance of 405.24 feet from a stone marking the northwest corner of Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Washington County, Oregon; thence North 89<sup>O</sup> 45' East a distance of 347.81 feet to an iron pipe; thence south 06<sup>O</sup> 11' East a distance of 259.69 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 89<sup>O</sup> 45' West a distance of 369.87 feet to an iron pipe; thence North Ol<sup>O</sup> 16' West a distance of 258.34 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.13 acres, more or less;
- 2. Also, a road right-of-way and perpetual easement therefor, 30 feet in width, being 15 feet on each side of the following described centerline: Beginning at a point which is south 01° 16' East a distance of 663.58 feet and North 89° 45' East a distance of 310 feet from the northwest corner of Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Washington County, Oregon, and thence South 55° East a distance of approximately 192 feet to the existing right of way of the county road; in Washington County Oregon;

This deed is made and accepted upon the following conditions subsequent: The Grantee shall construct, keep and maintain at its expense a stock-tight good and lawful fence enclosing the above described tract numbered 1., with a good and sufficient gate at point of entry thereto which gate shall be kept locked and closed except when ingress or egress to and from said area is necessary. Said fence to be erected complete by December 31, 1950.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said Grantee and its agsigns forever.

And the Grantors do covenant that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises free from all incumbrances, and that they will and their heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
