KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The Frontier Leather Company, Inc., a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon, Grantor, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 Dollars and other valuable consideration paid by the City of Sherwood, Oregon, a municipal corporation within and under the laws of the State of Oregon, Grantee, does hereby grant unto said Grantee, its successors and assigns, the following hereinafter described perpetual easement and temporary construction right of way upon, through, over and across those certain lands of the Grantor hereinafter described, in the County of Washington and State of Oregon, as follows:

- (a) A temporary construction right of way across and over the lands of the Grantor 20 feet in width, being 10 feet on the west side of the center line of the hereinafter described pipe line right of way; said temporary construction right of way to expire and terminate upon completion of the said pipe line installation and in any event not later than December 31, 1953;
- (b) A perpetual easement and right of way for an underground water pipe line upon, through, under and across the lands of the Grantor, including the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom at all reasonable times by agents, contractors and employees of the Grantee, and the right to excavate for, construct, reconstruct and maintain on and in said right of way said water supply pipe line; said right of way easement to extend 5 feet on each side of the center line described as follows:

In the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter ($SE_{4}^{1}SE_{4}^{1}$) of Section 29, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, W.M., Washington County, Oregon, beginning at a point on the south line of said Section 29 North 89° 59' East 1346.8 feet from the south quarter corner of said Section 29; thence northerly in a direct line to a point which is North 39° 9' West 5 feet from a point, which point is North 89° 59' East 1351.8 feet and North 0° 1' West 232.32 feet from the South quarter corner of said Section 29.

The rights and privileges herein granted to the Grantee are subject to and conditioned that the Grantee, its agents, employees and contractors shall suffer or do no damage to said property unless the same is fully repaired, shall restore grounds as nearly as possible and reasonable to the pre-existing condition, shall install, maintain and operate said pipe line in such manner and to such extent as to not unduly interfere with the continued use and enjoyment of the property by the Grantor for the purposes not incompatible with the rights herein granted, and shall save and hold harmless the

Grantor from any liability or damages whatsoever arising in connection with the Grantee's activities on said property.

The Grantor hereby warrants that it is possessed of a fee simple title and estate in the above described lands and that it has a full legal right to grant unto the Grantee herein named the easement right and privileges hereinabove set forth.
