EASEMENT FOR

ROADWAY CUT OR FILL SLOPE

This permanent easement is granted for the purpose of maintaining roadway cut or fill slopes thereunder, and the easement herein granted shall include the right for the Grantee to go over and under said land for the purpose of maintaining and repairing said slopes.

Grantor shall have use of the easement area for any purpose not inconsistent with and which does not interfere with or restrict the easement rights herein granted.

This right of way and easement is granted on condition that any work done by the CITY OF SHERWOOD pursuant hereto will be completed in a manner so as to restore the premises as nearly as practicable, consistent with the purposes of the easement, to the condition of the premises prior to construction. Any fences or pipes moved or affected by construction shall be replaced. It is a condition of the grant of this easement that the easement area shall be considered as a part of the square footage of grantors' premises for purposes of calculation of permissible building density and other land use requirements.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the herein described right of way and easement unto the CITY OF SHERWOOD, its successors and assigns, forever.
