JOHNSON, husband and wife, do hereby give, grant, dedicate and quitclaim to the CITY OF SHERWOOD, OREGON all of their right, title and interest in and to the following described real property in the County of Washington, State of Oregon:

A tract of land situated in the northwest quarter of Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Washington County, Oregon, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron bar (1/2"x3/4") found at the west quarter corner of said Sec. 32; thence along the West line of said Section, North 0 37'00" West, 689.00 feet to the porthwest corner of that tract of land described in deed to Jack & Johnson and Elaine S. 
