A 15' foot strip of land North of (if measured perpendicular to) and parallel with the most Northerly line of County Road No. 492 (Tualatin-Sherwood Road being sixty (60.00) feet in width).

All that portion of the above described easement which lies within Tax Lot No. 501, of the NE ½ of Section 28, Township 2 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Washington County, Oregon.

Grantor covenants with grantee that it is the owner in fee simple of said property, which is free of all encumbrances, and will warrant and defend the easement rights herein granted from all lawful claims whatsoever.

No monetary consideration is being received by grantor for this easement.
