Ordinance No. 96-1017

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF WEST VILLA ROAD, IN THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, WASHINGTON COUNTY, OREGON, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a portion of West Villa Road is a dedicated public right-of-way giving the public rights over the land for street and utility improvements; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this vacation is to vacate a portion of West Villa Road that is no longer needed for public use and because alternate access has been created; and

WHEREAS, concerns raised by residents adjacent to West Villa Road in regard to access to their properties and provisions for a turnaround when West Villa Road becomes a dead-end street, have been addressed by the City, and other issues raised by residents adjacent to West Villa Road have been determined by the Council to not be relevant to the appropriateness of the vacation; and

WHEREAS, all affected service providers, including utility companies and emergency services, have reviewed this vacation proposal and either have no objections or have recommended specific conditions of approval which have been incorporated into this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Council having considered the request on August 27, 1996 and September 24, 1996, finds that it is in the public interest to approve the request to vacate that portion of West Villa Road because the public interest will not be prejudiced by this vacation as provided by ORS 271.120.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Road Vacation. The Sherwood City Council hereby orders the vacation of those certain portions of public street right-of-way, as described on the attached Exhibit A-1 dated October 22, 1996, (map and legal description of areas to be vacated) and by this reference made part hereof.

After recording, return to:

Section 2. Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after passage and approval.


