PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER UTILITY EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Allen R. Methven, does forever grant unto the CITY OF SHERWOOD, a municipal corporation a permanent public sanitary sewer non-exclusive right-of-way and easement over and along the full width and length of the premises described as follows, to wit:

- 1. Legal description if set forth in EXHIBIT "A" attached hereto, and incorporated by reference herein.
- 2. A map of the above legal description is set forth in EXHIBIT "B" and incorporated by reference herein.

The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer stated in terms of dollars is \$-0-, however, the actual consideration consists of or includes other property or value given which is the whole consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

In the event the permanent public sanitary sewer right-of-way and easement shall no longer serve a public purpose, it shall revert back to the Grantor, his successors or assigns; and

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described permanent public sanitary sewer rightof-way and easement unto said Grantee in accordance with the conditions and covenants as follows;

- 1. The Grantee, through its officers, employees and agents, shall have the right to enter upon said lands in such a manner and at such times from this date as may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of construction, building, patrolling, replacing and maintaining thereon a public sanitary sewer pipe line, manholes and cleanouts along said right-of-way, including such renewals, repairs, replacements and removals as may be from time to time required, and to cut and remove from said right-of-way any trees and other obstructions which may endanger the safety or interfere with the use of said pipelines, appurtenances attached to or connected. No building shall be constructed over the pipeline easement right-of-way.
- 2. The Grantee, upon the initial installation, and upon each and every occasion that the same be repaired, replaced, renewed, added to, or removed, shall restore the premises of the Grantor, and any improvements disturbed by the Grantee, to as good condition as they were prior to any such installation work, including, but not limited to, the restoration of any topsoil, lawn and nursery stock of like kind and quality subject to reasonable substitution as may be necessitated by obstruction or interference with the use granted herein. Grantors and their successors in interest shall have the free and unobstructed use thereof, subject to rights of Grantee herein provided.

- 3. Grantee will make no unreasonable interference with such use of the surface of said land by Grantor and his successors in interest.
- 4. Grantor and his successors in interest will not be responsible for damage by others to said public utilities.
- 5. Grantee will indemnify and hold harmless the Grantor, his heirs and assigns from claims or injury to person or property as a result of the negligence of the Grantee, its agents or employees in the construction, operation or maintenance of said easement for public utilities.
- 6. THIS INSTRUMENT WILL NOT ALLOW USE OF THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THIS INSTRUMENT IN VIOLATION OF APPLICABLE LAND USE LAWS AND REGULATIONS. BEFORE SIGNING OR ACCEPTING THIS INSTRUMENT, THE PERSON ACQUIRING FEE TITLE TO THE PROPERTY SHOULD CHECK WITH THE APPROPRIATE CITY OR COUNTY PLANNING DEPARTMENT TO VERIFY APPROVED USES.


