Board Chair Colin Woodbury called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. in the Sherwood Senior Center

- The board reviewed and accepted the meeting minutes from the April meeting.
- Director's Report Starting July 1, use of the Senior Center requires paying rental cost. The location of the August meeting will be announced once a new site is found.
- The library board vacancy All candidates have been interviewed.
- Library building update Jenny, the new project manager for library construction, is now on contract with the city. The current view is that the library will share space w/City Hall. The library would be 18,000-20,000 sq. ft. Hacker and Associates have been chosen as the Architects.
- Library building update The board agreed with a city recommendation to demolish the Garrigus building and put up a sign stating that this is the location of the new library.
- CLAB CLAB is working on budgeting for FY 04-05. CLAB is discussing reimbursing
  collections dollar for dollar before the new formula is enacted. There will be more discussion at
  the next CLAB meeting.
- CLAB Are planning to put a levy on the May 2004 ballot for the same amount as the previous levy.
- The summer reading program begins mid June.
- There is a Polaris 3 release in mid June.
- WCCLS is restructuring fines starting July 1.
