Board Chair Colin Woodbury called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m in the Sherwood Senior Center

- The board reviewed and approved the meeting minutes from the June meeting.
- Ann updated the board on the November county levy including passing out information cards.
- Ann provided copies of ORS 260.432 for all members of the board. The board discussed the restrictions for political campaigning.
- The board discussed the insurance for board members and liability for committee members.
- Discussed an essay contest by the Friends of the Library entitled "What do you want to see in the new library?"
- The board discussed SURPAC's presentation to the city council. This presentation includes 5
 recommendations that will be considered for approval by the city council in their September meeting.
- Ann informed the board of the library budget reduction for the next budget period. This includes eliminating ½ open position and reducing the book budget by \$5000.
- It was moved (by Colin Woodbury), seconded (by Phyllis Chaney and Holli Robinson) and approved to accept the library Mission and library Selection Statements.
- The board discussed replacing the vacancy on the board.
- Holli made a motion to add a non-resident position to the board. The non-resident position would be from the Sherwood library service area, but outside of the city limit.
