

RESOLUTION 2019-017

AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE SHERWOOD SKATE PARK

WHEREAS, the City completed a Park Master Plan in 2006 and a skate park was identified as a desired amenity; and

WHEREAS, community skateboarders presented over 1,500 signatures to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and City Council in favor of a skate park in Sherwood; and

WHEREAS, in 2017 City Council prioritized the skate park in their Council Goals and directed staff to develop plans for a skate park facility; and

WHEREAS, City staff applied for a Local Government Grant from the Oregon Park and Recreation Department and was awarded \$326,014 towards the construction of a skate park; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids in December 2018 and Dreamland Skateparks LLC was identified as the lowest responsive bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Dreamland Skateparks LLC in an amount not to exceed \$509,530 for the completion of the Skate Park.
- Subject to the limitations of local and state contracting rules, the City Manager is hereby authorized to executed contract change orders for a total not to exceed \$76,429.50 (15% of the original award.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
