

## **RESOLUTION 2019-024**

## AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE 2019 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECTS

**WHEREAS**, the City has identified the pavement on SW Washington Street (between 2<sup>nd</sup> Street to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and between Willamette Street and the railroad tracks) and SW Foundry Avenue to be deficient and in need of replacement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has identified the need to install additional storm sewer within the City of Sherwood public works yard to alleviate ponding issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the City completed the design and produced bid documents to solicit contractors using a competitive bidding process meeting the requirements of local and state contracting statutes and rules (ORS 279C, OAR 137-049); and

**WHEREAS**, the City opened bids on April 4, 2019 and issued the Notice of Intent to Award with the mandatory seven (7) day protest period which is currently in process; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted for the construction cost of this project within the FY2018-19 budget; and

WHEREAS, S-2 Contractors, Inc. has been identified by city staff as the lowest responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends City Council to authorize the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the lowest responsive bidder from the April 4, 2019 bid opening (S-2 Contractors, Inc.) in a Base Contract Amount of \$429,502 with Construction Contingency of \$64,425.30 (15%) of the Base Contract Amount for the 2019 Pavement Rehabilitation Projects.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1:** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract upon the completion of the seven (7) day protest period with the lowest responsive bidder (S-2 Contractors, Inc.) in a Base Contract Amount of \$429,502 with Construction Contingency of \$64,425.30 (15%) of the Base Contract Amount for the 2019 Pavement Rehabilitation Projects.
- Section 2: This Resolution shall be in effect upon its approval and adoption.
