

RESOLUTION 2019-042

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THREE YEAR ON-CALL BUILDING PLAN REVIEW AND INSPECTION SERVICE CONTRACTS WITH CLAIR COMPANY AND NEW WORLD PLAN REVIEW

WHEREAS, the Sherwood Building Department is currently having commercial/industrial building plan review performed by a single contract services firm; and

WHEREAS, the Building Department is also anticipating continued growth in commercial/industrial development; and

WHEREAS, it is occasionally necessary to supplement the existing staff with additional assistance in both building plan review and inspection services in order to provide timely building department services; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised in both the Portland Daily Journal of Commerce and on the City's website a Request for Qualifications to develop a pool of qualified consultants to assist staff in the event that the workload compromises the timely service of building plan review and inspection services; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the qualifications and considering the firms' strengths and the City's needs, and in consideration that any one firm may not be fully available to meet a specific need at a given time, the Building Official and Community Development Director have recommended a pool of consultant firms; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the firms of Clair Company, Inc., and New World Plan Review LLC, be placed onto a three year on-call list to be utilized as needed to fulfill specific needs within the department.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The City Council accepts the Community Development Director and Building Official's recommendation to place Clair Company, Inc. and New World Plan Review LLC onto a three-year on-call consultant list.
- **Section 2.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a professional services agreement with both of the firms for a period of three years from the date the contract is signed.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
