

RESOLUTION 2019-048

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLACKLINE INC. FOR THE 2019 SLURRY SEAL PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City has a responsibility to maintain the City's infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City partnered with the City of Hillsboro to include Sherwood's 2019 Slurry Seal program in their RFP for the same services; and

WHEREAS, the RFP process identified Blackline Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Blackline, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$125,719.88

Subject to the limitations of local and state contracting rules, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contract change order(s) for a total amount not to exceed 10% of the original award (\$12,571.98).

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
