

RESOLUTION 2019-069

DESIGNATING THE SHERWOOD SKATE PARK FOR PUBLIC RECREATIONAL PURPOSES AND ADOPTING SKATE PARK RULES

WHEREAS, the City will soon complete construction of a skate park facility located in the vicinity of the intersection of SW Sunset Blvd and 99W (the "Sherwood Skate Park"); and

WHEREAS, the City desires the Sherwood Skate Park to be free and open to members of the public for recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City further desires to adopt rules relating to public use of the Sherwood Skate Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Sherwood Skate Park is hereby designated for public recreational purposes.
- **Section 2.** Use of the Sherwood Skate Park shall be subject to the Sherwood Skate Park Rules, attached hereto as Exhibit 1.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.

Skate Park Rules

PARK OPEN FROM 9:00 AM TILL DUSK

This skate park has been designated as an Outdoor Recreational Facility by the Sherwood City Council.

- This facility is not supervised. Skate at your own risk. The city is not responsible for injuries.
- The use of bikes in the park is prohibited.
- The use of helmets is required by law for all participants under the age of 16. The use of helmets, kneepads and elbow pads are strongly recommended for all ages.
- Be respectful of other park users. Respect lines and take turns. Moderate your language, keep music appropriate and at a reasonable level, and skate responsibly.
- Use trash containers provided. Glass containers are not allowed in the skate park.
- Alcohol, tobacco products (including vaping), marijuana products, and drugs are NOT allowed.
- Additional obstacles or other materials, like ramps and jumps, may not be used at the skate park.
- Use extreme caution when surface is wet.
- Violation of these rules may result in expulsion from the skate park.
