



RESOLUTION 2019-077

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH TIGARD AND KING CITY RELATED TO 99W CORRIDOR PLANNING

WHEREAS, Highway 99W (“Hwy”) is a critically important state highway in the southwest metro region under the jurisdiction of ODOT and located in the cities of Tigard, King City, Tualatin, Sherwood and in Washington County; and

WHEREAS, The Hwy is a critical state transportation facility in which the Parties have a shared interest to jointly plan future uses, designs, and improvement; and

WHEREAS, The Hwy requires a comprehensive corridor plan to coordinate and identify projects that will transition the facility from a typical 20th century commercial-automotive corridor to one that is safer, modernized, and conducive to climate-smart travel adaptations (e.g. transit); and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to engage with State of Oregon legislators on the funding of the Hwy Corridor Planning project in the 2020 legislative session; and

WHEREAS, Tigard has agreed to take the lead in coordinating and funding the engagement effort, with the assistance of CFM with Sherwood and King City providing staff support and a financial contribution of \$5,000 each toward the \$32,000 estimated project cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Sherwood City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to sign the IGA attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
