- ArtSmart, the first ever Center for the Arts day camp, is being launched this summer registration opens on February 20.

7. Public Art Master Plan Update (Sims/Hall)

Hall announced that the project is not eligible for the Oregon Cultural Trust Grant that was discussed in last month's meeting.
