## RESOLUTION 2020-010

### AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE MICHAEL COURT STORM SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, the City has identified the storm sewer and water quality swale between SW Michael Court and SW Lowell Lane to be deficient and in need of replacement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City completed the design and produced bid documents to solicit contractors using a competitive bidding process meeting the requirements of local and state contracting statutes and rules (ORS 279C, OAR 137-049); and

**WHEREAS**, the City opened bids on February 6, 2020 and issued the Notice of Intent to Award with the mandatory seven (7) day protest period which is currently in process; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has budgeted for the construction cost of this project within the FY2019-20 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, Banzer Construction Company has been identified by city staff as the lowest responsive bidder; and


**WHEREAS**, City staff recommends City Council to authorize the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the lowest responsive bidder from the February 6, 2020 bid opening (Banzer Construction Company) in a Base Contract Amount of \$182,735.10 with Construction Contingency of \$36,547.02 (20%) of the Base Contract Amount for the Michael Court Storm Sewer Rehabilitation Project.

### NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1:** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract upon the completion of the seven (7) day protest period with the lowest responsive bidder (Banzer Construction Company) in a Base Contract Amount of \$182,735.10 with Construction Contingency of \$36,547.02 (20%) of the Base Contract Amount for the Michael Court Storm Sewer Rehabilitation Project.

**Section 2:** This Resolution shall be in effect upon its approval and adoption.
